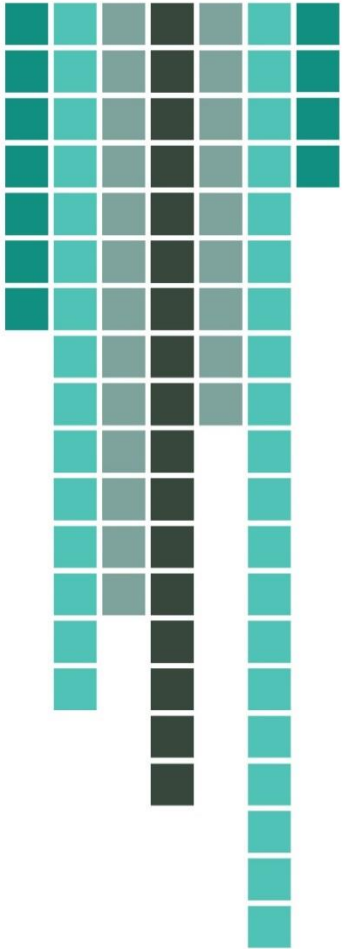

<p>Outline the rationale for the choice of assessment evidence used, i.e., why the evidence above was used and how it supported the grading decision:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Assessments were chosen where the whole cohort had completed the same assessments to enable fairness and consistency. Assessments 1 to 4 used exam board supplied assessment material (past exam paper material), with assessment 5 using the same structure as exam board set tasks (and using material from the previous GCSE specification). All were marked using the exam board mark schemes and moderated internally. This produced strong data to support the grading process.
