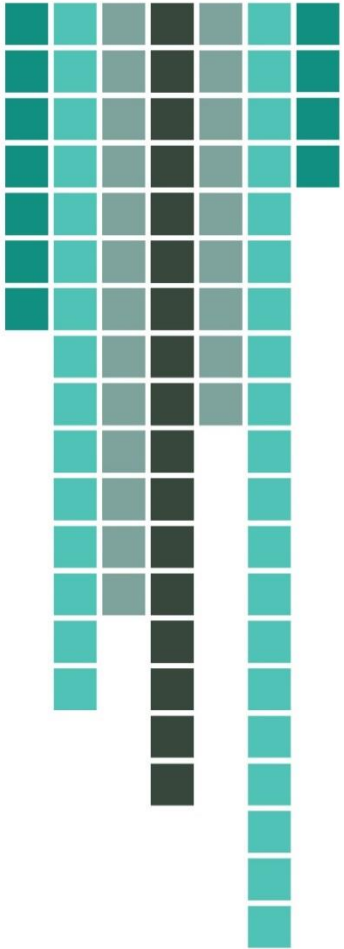

<p>Outline the rationale for the choice of assessment evidence used, i.e., why the evidence above was used and how it supported the grading decision:</p> <p>➤ Assessments were chosen where the whole cohort had completed the same assessments to enable fairness and consistency. All assessments used exam board supplied assessment material (past exam paper material). All were marked using the exam board mark schemes and moderated internally. In addition, assessments 1 and 4 were assessed through the ‘No More Marking’ website which ensured pupils’ work was marked anonymously and was rank-ordered. This produced strong data to support the grading process.</p>
