

Outline the rationale for the choice of assessment evidence used, i.e., why the evidence above was used and how it supported the grading decision:

- We had retained their mock papers, taken just before the start of the pandemic. These were completed in exam conditions, following a period of revision, and best emulates the exam experience. This was completed at a very high level of control and for almost all students in the cohort.
- The earlier mock exam did not test the students on two, at the time un-taught, parts of the course - urban issues and challenges, and challenge of natural hazards. To make sure we had both up to date and complete data we decided to complete, in as close to exam conditions as possible, past papers on these two units.
- Paper 3: Geographical Applications, had already been scaled back (by AQA) to no longer include their own fieldwork. Given time constraints and a lack of new papers to assess this unit we have decided to rely on skills-based questions in Educake. This, combined with the questions in the past papers that also assess the same skills, will allow all students to show how they can complete the variety of skills required for the course.
