Staggered Start and Finish Times from Monday 14 September

You may recall that, when we sent out the Returning to Eggar's Information pack last week and available on the school website here <https://www.eggars.net/attachments/download.asp?file=1328&type=pdf>, we would constantly review and scrutinise the changes we implemented, including the staggered start and finish times to the school day. We know that this has proved tricky for some working parents, those with more than one child attending the school, and the high proportion of students who travel to and from school on public transport. We have also been able to add some further health and safety measures relating to site access. Therefore, with effect from Monday 14 September we have adjusted the start and finish times as follows:

MORNINGS		
School opens from	08:00	Year 7 enter using the side gate leading to Maths (left of main entrance) Year 8 enter using the exit gate that leads to Holybourne Years 9/10/11 enter using the main gate All students who arrive at school before 08:20 must wait in the Refectory where breakfast will be provided if required.
School starts for all years	08:30	
AFTERNOONS		
School day ends for Year 7	14:20	Year 7 leave the site using the side gate (leading away from the Maths block)
School day ends for Year 8	14:25	Year 8 leave the site using the 'exit' gate (leading to Holybourne)
School day ends for Years 9/10/11	14:30	Years 9, 10 and 11 leave the site using the main gate

The staggered break and lunchtime arrangements will remain the same.

We can see that, nationally, guidance and expectations are changing daily and we must continue to review our practice. Face masks continue to be mandatory on public transport and 'advisable' but not mandatory in communal areas at the moment. However, this will remain under constant review.

Thank you for your continued support as we do everything possible to keep our school community safe.
