



Eggar's School uniform requirements

All our students are required to wear school uniform. We believe a uniform is really important, giving our students a strong sense of both belonging and of identity.

All students must wear the correct uniform in school and at school events or activities. They must also wear the uniform on the way to and from school. Students who do not have the correct full uniform should bring a note from home explaining the reason to their tutor.

The judgement of the school is final in all issues relating to uniform. All students are required to be presented for school wearing the following uniform.

Shirt	Plain white, buttoned to collar, long sleeved shirt for boys/girls (no t-shirts or sports shirts)	✓

Trousers	Plain black trousers for boys/girls. See www.skoolkit.co.uk for required style NO jeans, chinos, fashion styled skinny/drainpipes, tight Lycra, jeggings/leggings or low waisted 'hipster' style trousers allowed	✓	
Shorts	Optional: tailored black shorts (unisex), only available from Skoolkit, can be worn during the summer term only.		✓
Boys' socks	Plain black or grey for boys	✓	
Girls' socks	Short plain white socks may be worn in the summer		✓
Girls' tights	Plain black 40 denier or natural coloured tights (no footless leggings or knee high socks)	✓	
Girls' skirt	Green kilt, knee length; from 07 November 2020 available from Skoolkit not Eggar's School	✓	
Shoes	Black shoes, traditional style. NO boots, trainer style, canvas pumps or high heels allowed.	✓	
Jumper	V-neck plain black jumper that allows school tie to be clearly visible	✓ Oct - Apr	

General Appearance

- Outer coats must not be denim or leather.
- Strictly no “hoodies” or sweatshirts are allowed.
- Hairstyles should be appropriate for school and not extreme in terms of colour, style or length.
- No jewellery is allowed other than a wristwatch.
- Earrings/piercings (including nose) are not allowed.
- No make-up and/or nail varnish/false nails allowed.

Protective Clothing

- It is advisable that students wear aprons for lessons in the Technology, Art and Science.
Goggles or eye shields will be provided when needed in Science and Technology lessons.
