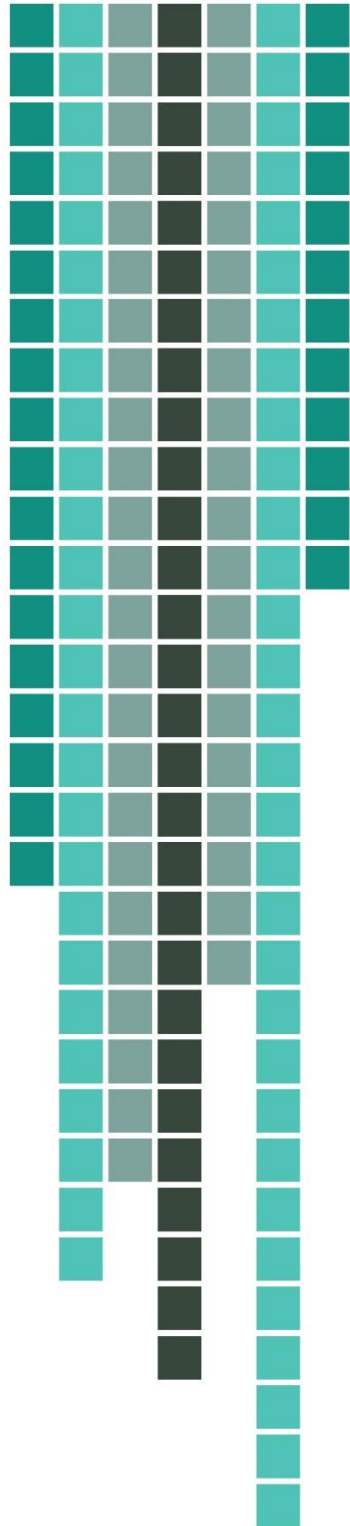

## Careers Access Policy Statement

## Introduction

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing 'careers and provider access' to meet careers statutory guidance. The legal framework for careers guidance in secondary schools, has been strengthened in 2023, fulfilling commitments made in the [skills for jobs white paper](#). New legislation was introduced through the Skills and Post-16 Education Act 2022 and the Education (Careers Guidance in Schools) Act 2022.

Since September 2022, all state funded secondary schools must now secure independent careers guidance for pupils from years 7 to 13. From 1 January 2023, the Department for education has also strengthened the provider access legislation, making it a legal requirement for schools to ensure all pupils during school years 8 to 13 have at least 6 opportunities to meet a range of providers of approved technical education qualifications and apprenticeships.

Schools must ensure that these requirements are followed. Updated [careers statutory guidance](#) sets out what is expected under the new requirements.

All students in Years 8 – 11 at Eggars School are entitled to:

- find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point;
- hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events;
- understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.
