



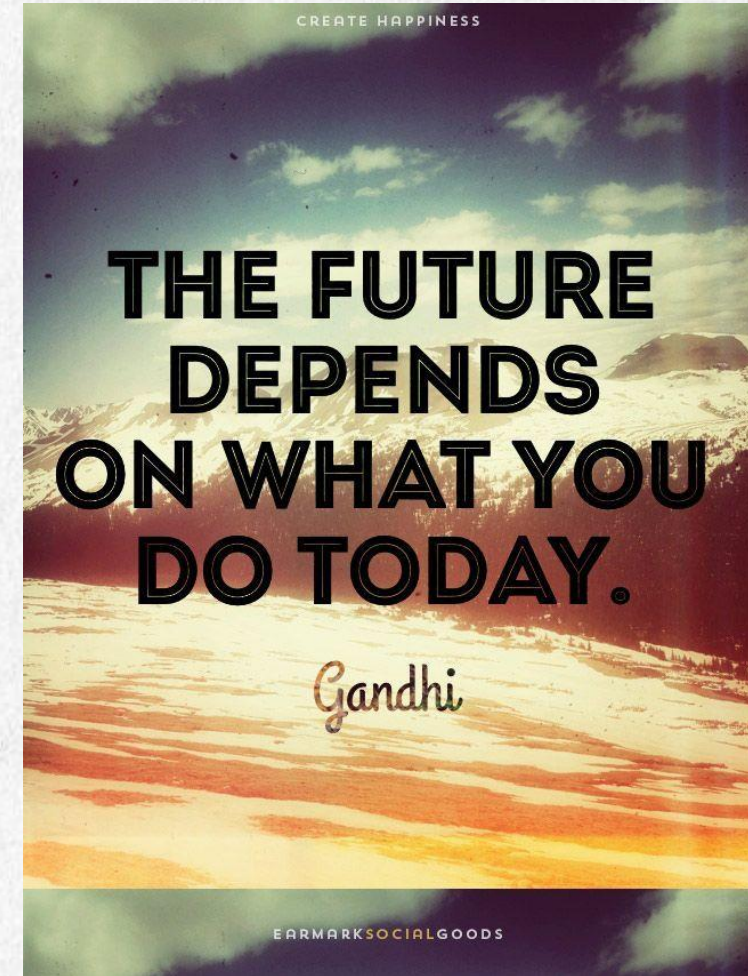

As you watch the video, try to count the different transferrable skills used.

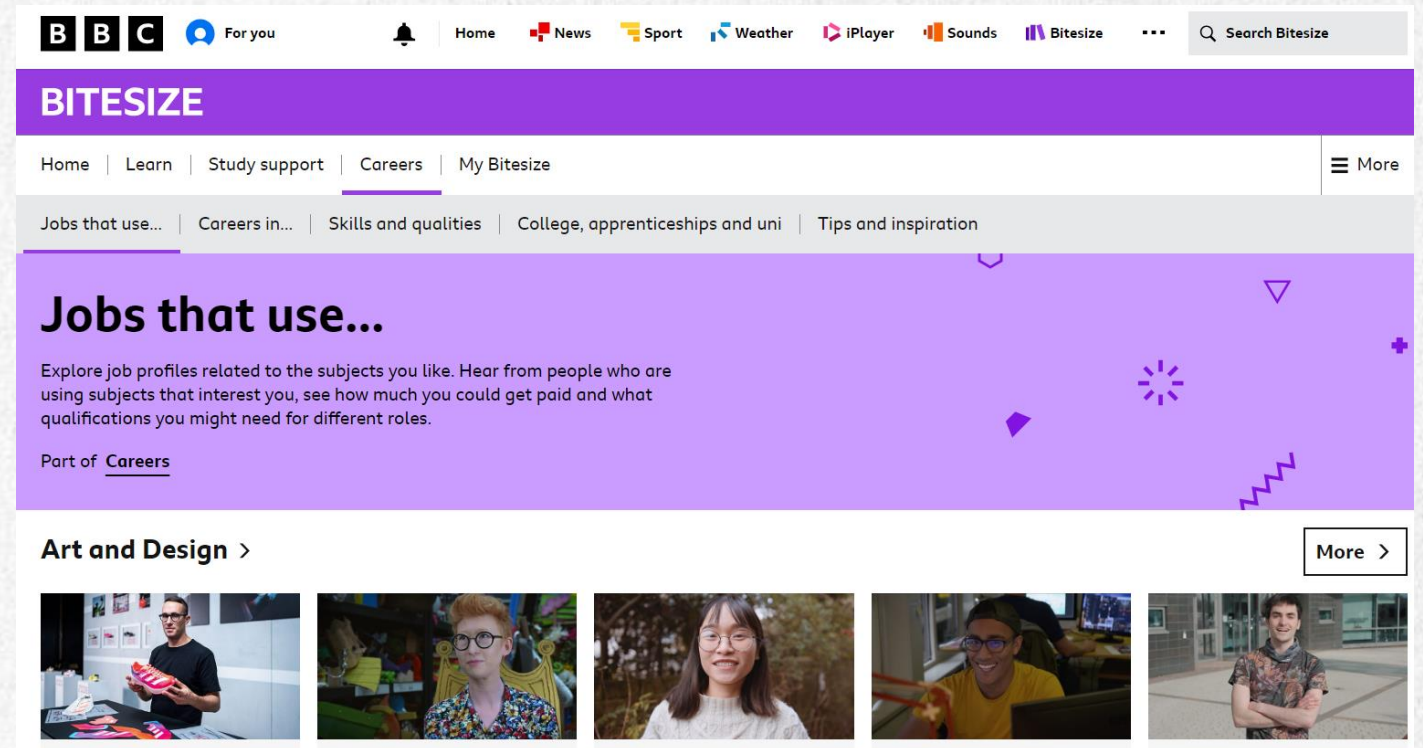
Step-up: Are transferrable skills something you have or do they be developed over time?



Where can your skills take you?


Activity – Class Research
