THE SPEAKING OF VERSE AND PROSE

The Speaking Verse and Prose syllabus is designed to develop the skills necessary for effective oral communication of the written word and would suit children with a passion for talking to those shy children that might benefit from some formal teaching to develop a clear speaking voice, positive body language and self-confidence.

THE ACTING SYLLABUS

The Acting syllabus is designed to improve self-esteem and develop physical presence and a strong speaking voice; all the skills necessary to communicate a dramatic text to an audience. This syllabus would suit more confident children who have a love of drama and acting.

THE LAMDA LESSONS

1-1 or 1-2 lessons can last anywhere between 20 minutes to one hour, depending on the grade of exam, whether lessons are during curriculum hours or extra-curricular, or how close to exams students are. Group lessons typically last between 45 minutes to one hour. Lessons are traditionally term time only.

THE COST

Costs vary depending on length of lesson, grade and whether the lessons are group based 1-1 or 1-2. Costs are valid until December 2024. Examination fees are extra and start from £30 per exam. These would be payable once a student is being entered for an exam. As a general rule, a Year 5 student would typically begin on Grade 1 or 2. A Year 7 student would begin on Grade 3 or 4, all with a view to achieving Grade 8/Gold Medal by the time he/she leaves college or Sixth Form. However, please note this is entirely dependent on experience and capability and would vary pupil to pupil. Our first few lessons will determine which Grade the pupil should work towards.
