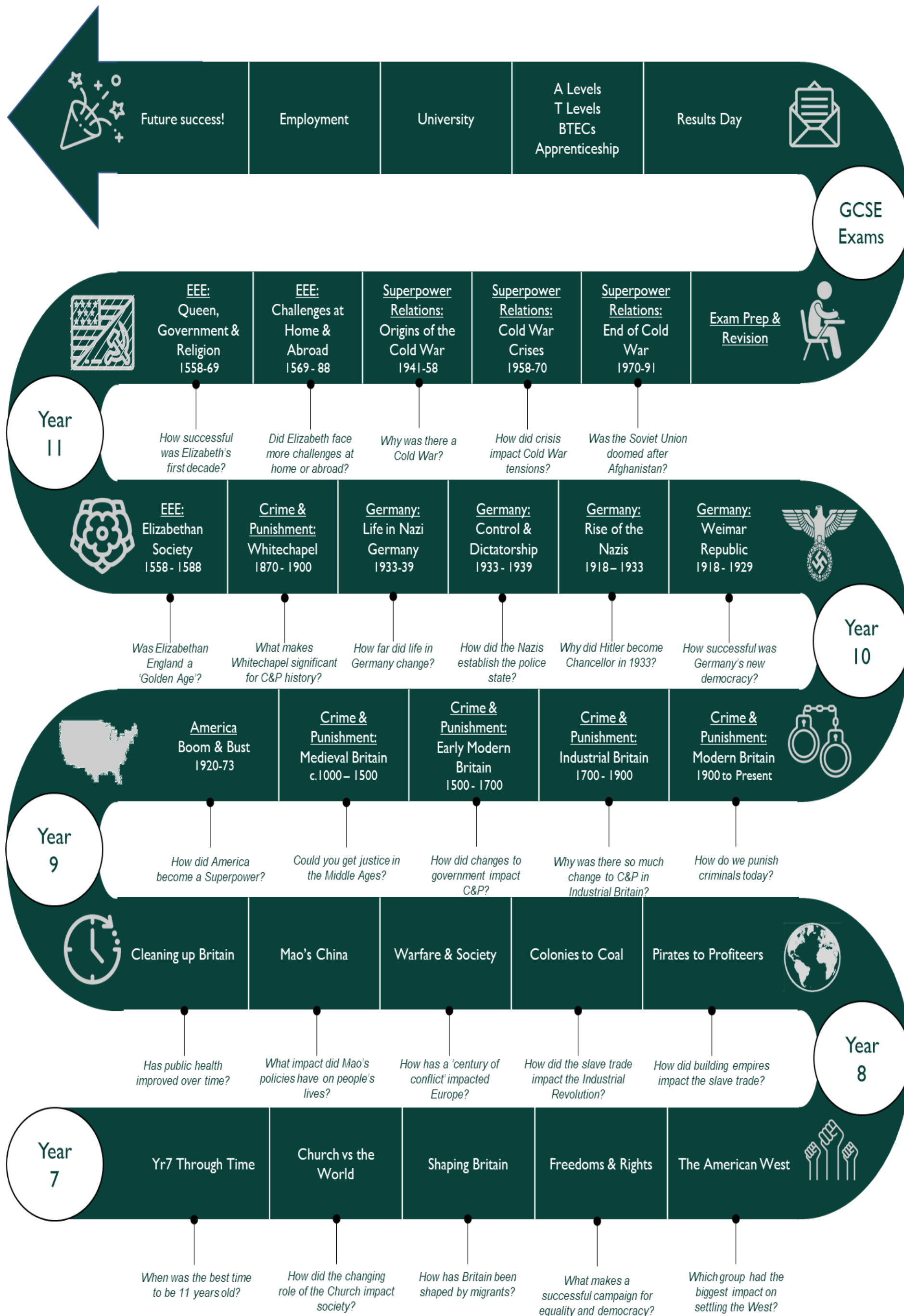


History Department LEARNING JOURNEY



History is the study of people, places and moments in time that have shaped our past, present and future. Without History, students would have no context in which place their lives and experiences. By studying History we learn key transferrable skills, such as how to analyse and communicate ideas and opinions, which are integral to success in all aspects of life beyond Eggar's.

Our curriculum is sequenced using thematic chronology. This allows students to build their understanding of the place of time and connections between topics. We have built our curriculum to provide students with a foundation of requisite skills and contextual knowledge within the KS3 curriculum, which is consolidated and extended at GCSE, where we follow the Edexcel (9-1) specification.
