The **Home School Agreement** as signed by the Parent/Carer, Tutor and Student is as follows:

The Parent/Guardian/s will:

- ensure that my/our child goes to school regularly, on time and properly equipped.
- ensure that my/our child wears uniform as expected by the school and, when doing so, represents the school in the community with pride and dignity.
- make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's work or behaviour by contacting my child's tutor in the first instance.
- support the school's policies and reinforce with my/our child the expected guidelines for their behaviour, including our lunchtime and same day afterschool consequences.
- support my/our child in all aspects of home learning.
- not contact my child during the school day via their electronic device.
- log on to the relevant online platforms to keep updated on how my child is getting on at school (Arbor Parent Portal) and to report on absence (StudyBugs).
- attend parents' evenings and discussions about my/our child's progress.
- get to know about my/our child's life at the school and what they are learning.
- attend parent information events and use website resources to support with learning at home.
- keep up to date on curriculum content via Eggar's News and the school website.

- provide a balanced curriculum which challenges and supports the individual needs of your child.
- focus on student wellbeing to ensure students are happy at school enabling them to thrive in a positive learning environment.

- provide the infrastructure for the use of digital technologies in learning and provide resources to support home learning.
- provide opportunities for students outside of the classroom as part of The Eggar's Experience.

- be ready to learn by ensuring you have all equipment required.
- enter and exit classrooms as expected.
