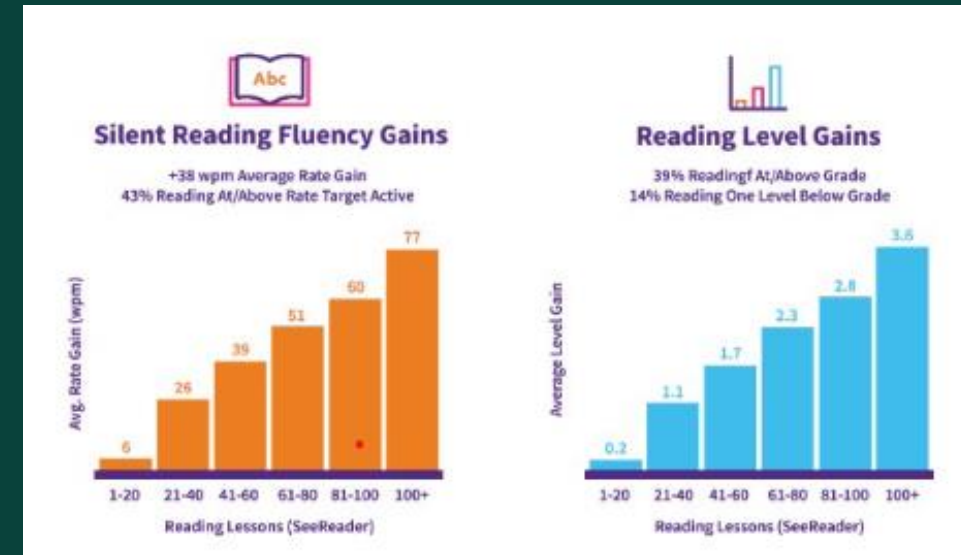


Reading Plus:

- Is an online reading programme that's packed full of engaging texts
- Covers reading learning from KS1 to KS4
- Is research based and proven to work
- Teaches silent reading fluency, comprehension and vocabulary
- Is personalised to meet each student's needs

All year 7 students will be set Reading Plus homework after completing the baseline assessment in school.

The more they do, the more progress they will make!

# Reading Plus

***The more you put in, the more you get out!***

Data from the top 25 readers in Year 7 last year:

- Average comprehension scores were 88%
- Average lessons completed over the year was 75
- Average progress made with comprehension skills 4 years
- Average fluency gain 60 words per minute

In contrast, the 25 at the other end of the scale:

- Average comprehension scores were 61%
- Average lessons completed over the year was 23
- Average progress made with comprehension skills 1 year
- Average fluency gain 11 words per minute

## Key points:

Complete at least 3 lessons a week

Maintain comprehension average over 80%

This results in greater fluency and better comprehension skills
