Full school uniform is required. Coats and bags must be left in lockers, as they are not permitted in the exam hall.

Mobile phones, watches, and any electronic devices—such as fitness trackers, AirPods, or revision notes/materials—must not be brought into the exam hall.

Please ensure you bring all necessary equipment for each exam in a clear pencil case.

Remember to bring any specific Maths equipment and a calculator for Science and Maths exams, or for any other subject where required. We have a limited supply of spare calculators, but they may not have the same functions as those you are used to.

We recommend bringing a bottle of water to stay hydrated. Please ensure it is a clear plastic bottle with all labels and logos removed.
