MEDICAL ROOM

Our medical room is in Student Services and accessible during the school day. One of our trained first aiders will support students who feel unwell. They are on hand to discuss symptoms and administer any first aid required. They will call home if your child is too unwell to stay in school.



MEDICINES, INHALERS & INJECTORS

All medicines should be held in the Medical Room, in their original box or bottle with the name of the medication and dosage information. Students must not carry medication in their bags or self-administer medication. An 'Administration of Medication Consent Form' can be obtained from Reception, and filled out. We can store and administer any long-term, short-term or occasional use medication. If your child has a medical condition that requires an inhaler or injector, they are expected to always carry one. It is important that we have a secondary inhaler or injector for your child in case of any emergency. Please provide this to Student Services where it will be safely stored. We do store an emergency inhaler and injector, which are taken outside in the event of the fire alarm being activated.

PARACETAMOL

The school hold a small quantity of paracetamol in school for in the case of emergency use only. If students require regular paracetamol to be administered, this must be provided by the parent/carer in a clearly labelled box which is handed in to reception. Please ensure that your child's tutor is aware of any medical issues which require the regular use of paracetamol.
