

# EGGAR'S TRANSITION MODERN FOREIGN LANGUAGES

In Year 7, students will be randomly selected to study either French or Spanish and they will continue this language into Year 8. Focusing on one language throughout KS3 means that they will have built a strong foundation of language, grammar and skills by the time they move to KS4.

Students at Eggar's are expected to study a Language at GCSE as we believe it is an important part of providing a rounded and rich educational experience, and they will continue with the language they have studied in KS3 into GCSE level. It may be reassuring to bear in mind that either French or Spanish will provide a secure foundation for the acquisition of any other languages in later life.

If your child has a valid reason for studying either French or Spanish when they start at Eggar's (e.g. family living in the country, native speaker in the family, etc) this can be accommodated by completing a **form**.

It must be noted that, owing to the fixed parameters of class sizes, it will not be possible to change language preferences once started in Year 7 and, therefore, careful consideration is advised.
